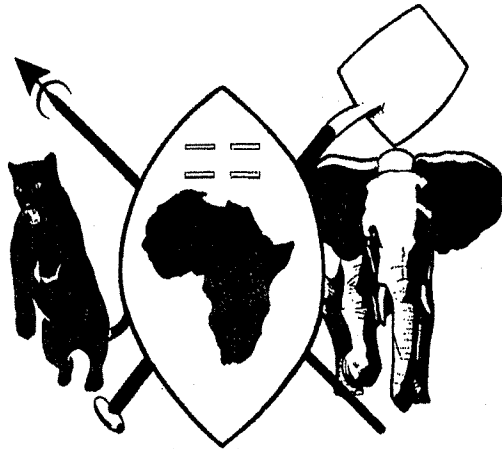

In many cases our members/subscribers are indigent prisoners. If you can afford to, please double your donation and be a "sustaining member."

The New Afrikan Service Organization (formerly the Black Brigade), is a mass organization dedicated to service to the Nation of Afrikans in Amerika. It is composed of people of various walks of life, men and women, religious and non-religious, revolutionary and non-revolutionary. Our basis of unity is service and commitment to uplift the Black communities. Non-Black people who are willing to share this commitment and to work to serve our Nation and our communities are welcome to join us too.

There are no "inactive members" of NASO. We expect our members to be actively engaged in some aspect of the struggle on a regular basis. If you are in prison, you can be actively working to turn these "Slave Pens of Oppression" into "Schools of Liberation."

Every housing unit should have its detachment of NASO, led by a chairperson, whose members study together and uplift each other and those around them. Every opportunity to serve The People should be taken and new programs initiated to provide for the prisoners' basic survival needs and the upliftment of the prison population.

Outside support committees, composed of relatives, loved ones and prisoner rights activists, should be formed to help build the fight and end human rights abuses in the prisons. They should assist in the publication and distribution of newsletters, do public speaking and campaign to amend the 13th Amendment, which perpetuates the status of "slave" for prisoners, to abolish the racist death penalty, the sentence of life without parole, "three strike" laws, and "special housing units."

The Universal Declaration of Human Rights should be applied to Amerika's prisons, and torture, guard brutality, and other human rights violations should be exposed and ended. We are not animals, and we must assert our rights as men and women!

We must end the alienation from our inalienable rights! We raise the battle-cry of "*No Incarceration Without Representation!*" Prisoners in Europe have won the right to vote, and we should accept no less!



Give us the opportunity to make productive citizens of ourselves so we can give back to our communities!

We demand amnesty and freedom for our political prisoners; an end to the placement of the mentally ill in jails and prisons; and alternatives to prison for non-violent offenders. We demand decent health care and a wholesome, nutritious diet; cultural, educational and rehabilitative programs designed and run by prisoners; and an end to the exploitation of convict labor.

You can't teach good citizenship through slavery or respect for life and the rights of others by brutality!

In the oppressed communities, where our people are concentrated, our aim is to build and defend community control and People's Power. This must be built block by block and neighborhood by neighborhood. We need to establish neighborhood councils, composed of respected

elders and veteran community activists, and empower them to give leadership to our communities, and collectively to our Nation.

We need to create Serve The People (STP) programs, like the Black Panthers' Free Breakfast For Children Program, to help The People meet their basic survival needs and become self-reliant. We need to combat the spread of the deadly AIDS virus and other debilitating diseases, like Hepatitis and TB, provide legal assistance, combat gang violence, organize drug and alcohol recovery programs, and provide for The Peoples' basic security.

We have the legal right to form our own community security forces, just as the gated communities of the rich have theirs. We can also augment these professional, armed patrols and investigators with volunteers equipped with radios, cell-phones and video cameras, and with neighborhood watch committees. We know the police and prosecutors are on the take and provide protection for the illegal capitalists who run crime in our communities – and we can prove it!

The future belongs to the youth and the children, and it is for them we dare to struggle. The Black Brigade supports the formation of a national, multi-ethnic Warrior Youth Organization (W.Y.O.) to prepare the upcoming generation to create a radically different future for humanity.
